  - □ Can the student explain the strong relationship between Calgarians and how they connect with the downtown spaces in their own words and provide powerful, clear examples from their build?
  - □ Does the explanation encourage citizens to connect, live, work and play downtown?
  - □ References to the four pillars in their build/design \*(based on age group)
